As South Carolina responds to the COVID-19 virus, we remain open and ready to assist taxpayers. Our top priority is the health and safety of our customers and employees. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we face the challenges of COVID-19 together.

We have made no change to Alcohol Beverage Licensing (ABL) requirements in South Carolina's laws and regulations. Any business with an On-Premises Beer/Wine Permit is authorized to sell beer and wine to-go. Customers may enter the business or walk up (**NOT** drive up) to a window to purchase beer and wine to-go. Learn more about license regulations at dor.sc.gov/tax/abl/licenses.

It is illegal to sell beer, wine, and liquor through curbside, delivery, or drive-thru service. It is also illegal for businesses with a Liquor by The Drink License to sell liquor to-go. The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) will continue to enforce South Carolina's ABL laws and regulations.
